** DOCUMENTATION: Domestic Travel: Valid government issued photo ID is required at airport check-in for every passenger 18 years or older. Passenger's identification must match the name on ticket. AAA recommends all travelers carry valid government issued ID. International Travel:

All persons, including U.S. citizens, traveling by air between the United States and Canada, Mexico, Central or South America, the Caribbean and Bermuda will be required to present a valid passport. That passport cannot expire within 6 months of your return date. If you are a citizen of another country there may be additional requirements. Non-U.S. citizens are responsible for checking with the nearest consulate of the destination to which you are traveling, for all entry requirements. The names on all appropriate

** AIRPORT CHECK-IN: Check-in at least 2 hours prior to flight departure time for domestic travel and 3 hours prior for international travel. An Electronic ticket (ETKT) is a paperless ticket. You are provided with an itinerary. Boarding passes are issued upon check-in at the airport. Late arrivals may be denied boarding without compensation.
