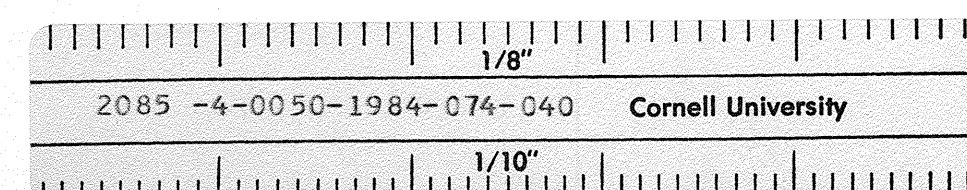
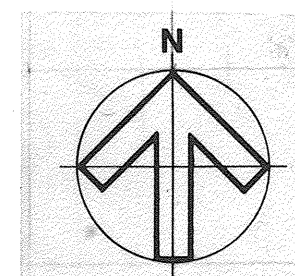
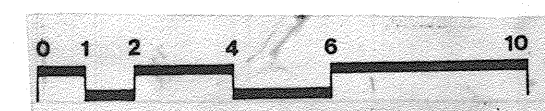
DRAWING NOTES

- ① EXISTING LIGHT FIXTURE TO REMAIN.
- ② EXISTING LIGHT FIXTURE TO BE RELOCATED.
- ③ RELOCATED LIGHT FIXTURE, MODIFY CIRCUITING AS REQUIRED.
- ④ EXISTING LIGHT FIXTURE TO BE REMOVED.
- ⑤ NEW WIRING DEVICE LOCATION, CUT IN NEW DEVICE IN EXISTING WALL, PATCH AND PAINT TO MATCH EXISTING SURROUNDINGS.
- ⑥ CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY EXISTING LIGHTING CIRCUITING IN THIS AREA. MODIFY EXISTING CIRCUITS AS REQUIRED TO SERVICE NEW LIGHTING LAYOUT AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS.
- ⑦ EXTEND EXISTING LIGHTING CIRCUIT AS REQUIRED TO NEW FIXTURE AND SWITCH.
- ⑧ CONNECT NEW EXIT FIXTURE TO EXISTING EXIT FIXTURE CIRCUITING IN EXISTING BUILDING.
- ⑨ NIGHT LIGHT FIXTURE, CONNECT TO NIGHT LIGHT CIRCUIT FROM PANE "DP" IN ROOM 311.
- ⑩ COORDINATE UNDERCOUNTER LIGHTING AND SWITCHING WITH ARCHITECT, IN FIELD.
